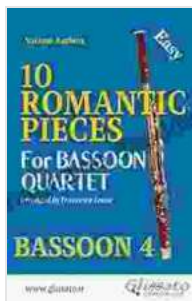


10 Unforgettable Romantic Pieces for Bassoon Quartet Enchanting the Musical Landscape

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1. Franz Anton Hoffmeister - Quartet in D Major, Op. 41, No. 2

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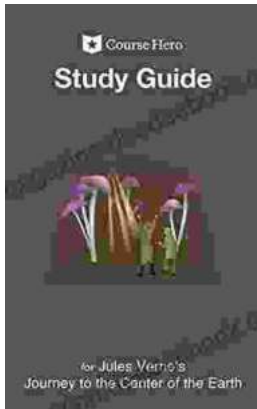
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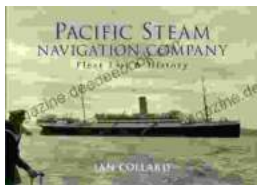
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
