


Six Drumset Etudes For The Beginning To Intermediate Performer: The Ultimate Guide to Technique and Performance

Arranged Chronologically by LCM (Lowest-Highest)

Noah Pilatoff (aka Rummy)

Section 1 (2:3, 60 BPM):

- S (Snare):** 3 strokes per measure. The first measure has a dynamic of *mp*. The second measure has a dynamic of *mf*.
- B (Bass):** 2 strokes per measure.

Section 2 (2:3, 120 BPM):

- S (Snare):** 5 strokes per measure.
- B (Bass):** 3 strokes per measure.

Section 3 (2:7, 60 BPM):

- S (Snare):** 7 strokes per measure.
- B (Bass):** 2 strokes per measure.

Etude 4: Fills

Fills are short, improvised passages that connect different sections of a song. This etude explores various types of fills, including single-stroke fills, double-stroke fills, and paradiddle fills.



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
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
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
